OLD AND RARE TOKAJI



TOKAJI MUSEUM COLLECTION

Our company, Tokaj Kereskedőház Rt. has a large collection of museum stock wine. There are a considerable number of wines from the beginning of the 1900s. The oldest bottle is from the late 1680s.

We stock wines from the most exquisite vintage years and the very best vineyards in our Wine Museum. Years of aging in fine wooden barrels gives the wines a quality and maturity. Bottle maturation then redefines all of these tastes and creates perfect taste-aroma harmony. The main characteristics of our museum collection wines, both in taste and aroma, are traces of sun-dried fruits, raisins, nuts and chocolate, with long lasting after-tastes and elegance. These are the real treasures of our winemakers, and they continue dazzling the finest wine experts from all over the World. The best proof is in the hundreds of golden medals—among them a couple of Bordeaux Grand Prix—given to our Aszús.

The underground cellars were carved in riolite tufa in the 13th century. Their temperature is 10-12 °C, with a relative humidity of 88-90%, which has a favorable influence on the long, bottle maturation process. The walls of the cellars are covered with a wallpaper of velvet like, dark gray cellar mould. This also covers the bottles themselves giving an almost unreal atmosphere in the cellars. Due to this special and unique environment the Aszú wines can be stored for more than a hundred years. The wine from this Museum has a certificate of origin, signed by the cellarmaster, and tied to the neck of the bottle.
