'King of Wines, Wine of Kings' - this is Tokaji Aszú, a rich, honeyed dessert wine balanced with refreshing acidity, made using wine-making techniques dating back to 1631. This *Great First Growth* Aszú is from the former Imperial *Szarvas* vineyard, an outstanding 40ha estate nestled at the foot of the Tokaj mountain.

Crown Estates, the leading Hungarian owned producer of Tokaji Aszú, forms part of Hungary's national heritage: as well as the *Szarvas* vineyard they own the unique Museum Cellar stocked with outstanding wines dating back to 1906.

Aszú wines are made when, aided by climatic conditions, botrytis concentrates the grape sugars in the hand picked, raisin-like grapes - Aszú berries. The wine is aged skilfully in cask for a minimum of 3 years. The Puttonyos number - 3 to 6 - indicate the amount of Aszú grapes used.
