

CASTLE ISLAND Tokaji Hárslevelű from Crown Estates of Hungary takes its name from the Castle that dominated the river at Tokaj, in this historic wine region, before 1705.

The 2000 Tokaji vintage was the finest for many years. In this distinctive dry wine our wine-making team, advised by AngelaMuir MW (master of wine), combine the region's heritage with modern wine-making practice, to produce a fresh, crisp young wine.

Hárslevelű means 'limeleaf' (from the shape of the vine leaf). CASTLE ISLAND Tokaji Hárslevelű is well suited to seafood or modern spiced dishes. Elderflower and lime blossom on the nose and a fresh floral palate make this the perfect aperitif for warm spring or summer evenings.
